Minutes

The minutes of the April meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report

Our current budget stands at \$4317.65. This includes an expense of \$124.31 for advertising and permits for the yard sale, May 14, 2016. We have collected \$115 in permit fees from participants, but these and future revenues have not been processed.

Old Business

Spring Clean-Up: This took place on April 30. Sherry thanked all the many volunteers who participated in the neighborhood clean-up to make it a successful event this year.

Yard Sale: We anticipate having some 23 participants in the yard sale. Permits cost \$10.00 per street, and we have purchased them for Hudson Ave, Kibler St, and Charles St. We have purchased additional permits for specific addresses on Mt Vernon Rd and Elizabeth St.

North Street Park, Beautification Committee: The city has painted equipment at the park. We expect donations from the private sector for fencing (about \$2,400 from McCoy's Fence Co.), topsoil (Home Depot), and mulch. Raised beds, rain-barrels and city sponsored lighting are being addressed.

"Movies in the park" in late June or early July is an idea that is being considered for formal gatherings.

New Business

Progressive Dinner: HHCA intends to hold the "Progressive Dinner" this July 14. We seek volunteers to host the three different components of the event.

It was suggested that HHCA invite new residents as guests to this event.
